



How to use your TranBen voucher

Your TranBen is treated like cash to add value to your ORCA card



1. Visit a participating retailer

- Many stores will add the voucher value onto your card for you. Call ahead to ensure TranBen is accepted.
- Turn flier over for a list of South King County retailers or visit OrcaCard.com

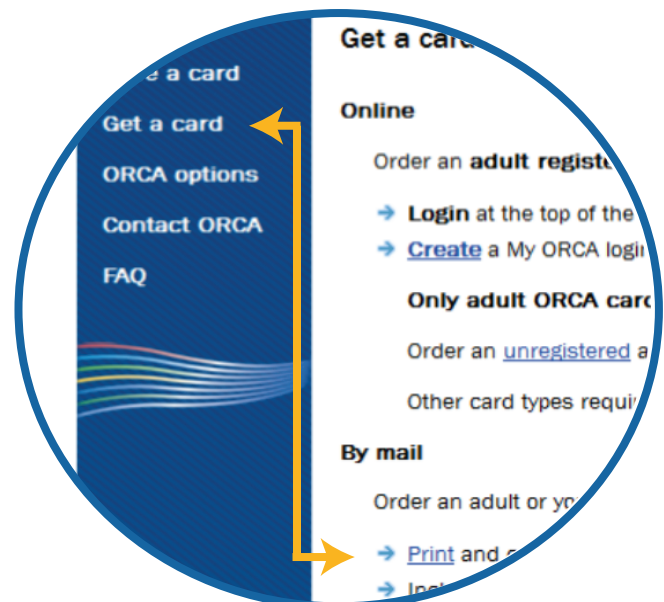
