Official Contest Information

Share how you reduce waste, reuse items and/or recycle correctly with a drawing, photo, photo of an art piece, or a short video (60 seconds or less) you created. Win up to \$350. Winning entries will be shared on City of Tukwila and Waste Management websites, social media, and featured in an Earth Day news release. Some winning entries may be posted in Tukwila Parks on a poster or banner.

What should my film or photo include?

Tips to teach others how to reduce waste, reuse items, or recycle properly. Here are some examples:

- Show what you do at home to reduce waste.
- Show how you remember what is recyclable and what belongs in the garbage. Check out <https://www.wmnorthwest.com/tukwila/> for recycling information.
- Show creative ways to reuse items.
- Get creative and have fun!

Submissions will be judged by a City of Tukwila and Waste Management panel based on creativity, relevance to the waste reduction/recycling theme, quality, and effort. Waste Management reserves the right to exclude any entries deemed non-suitable or inappropriate.

If chosen as the winner, your artwork may be shown in public spaces, such as the Tukwila library or a City park.

Who can enter?

- All Tukwila School District Elementary, Middle, or High School Students.
- All Elementary, Middle, or High School Students who live in the City of Tukwila but go to school elsewhere.

When are entries due and when are finalists announced?

- **Entries are due by Friday, April 8th – 5:00 PM**
- **Finalists will be announced by noon on Thursday April 21st, the day before Earth Day**

How do I submit my entry?

- Send your completed application form and video/photo submission to recyclenw@wm.com
- If your video file is too large to send via email you can:
 - Upload it to YouTube or Vimeo and send us a link (You will need to have an account)
 - Use a free program to condense the file size of your video so it can be sent via email
- Videos should be 60 seconds or less.
- Video format should be in *.mov, *.mpr, *.mpeg or *.avi format.
