

2018 South King County Bike Rack Program

The South King County Transportation Options team, housed within the City of Tukwila, is pleased to announce a bike rack grant program for 2018, available to businesses and organizations located in the cities of Tukwila, Renton, Kent, SeaTac, Burien, or Federal Way. The program is funded through a Regional Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) grant that the City of Tukwila received to reduce air pollution, traffic congestion, and fuel consumption by encouraging active transportation (bicycling or walking) or transit use.

Bike racks will be available to grant recipients starting in Spring 2018. Quantities are limited, and proposed locations will be reviewed prior to approval. Grant recipients are limited to a maximum award of two (2) bike racks per location. Once a grant application is approved, the recipient will be responsible for bike rack installation and maintenance.
