The Department of Community Development Code Enforcement team envisions a Tukwila where every property is a beacon of community *pride*. Through community *collaboration* and shared *responsibility*, Tukwila is the *Community of Choice*.

MISSION

The mission of the Tukwila Code Enforcement Team is to gain compliance with the Tukwila Municipal Codes, that directly relate to the conditions existing on private property, through public awareness, communication, and cooperation. The Code Enforcement team works with community members to provide information, resources, and collaborative efforts to help bring properties into compliance.

The Tukwila Code Enforcement Team works to support a safe, inviting, and healthy environment for residents, businesses, and visitors.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Tukwila Municipal Code represents the City of Tukwila's laws adopted by the Tukwila City Council. Code Enforcement is responsible for enforcing the parts of the Code that relate to conditions of private property.

Our Code Enforcement Officers respond to complaints and encourage compliance with the Tukwila Municipal Code. Some of the most frequent issues addressed by Code Enforcement include:

TRASH & DEBRIS WEED OVERGROWTH

JUNK VEHICLES PARKING

GRAFFITI

If a violation is found, a case is opened. Our team works with property owners to reach compliance. Compliance is typically reached through promoting public awareness, communication, and collaboration.

We encourage community members to reach out to our Code Enforcement Team with any concerns they may have related to private property code compliance.
