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# **PUBLIC WORKS RIGHT-OF-WAY USE PERMIT FEE ESTIMATE WORKSHEET**

### **What is a Right-of-Way Use Permit?**

On November 21, 2022, the City adopted updates to Tukwila Municipal Code (TMC) Chapter 11.08 under Ordinance 2682. The updates consolidated the right-of-way permit subtypes into two categories – Right-of-Way Use Permits (ROWUP) and Annual Activities Blanket Permits (AABP). The ROWUP is required for both franchise holders and non-franchise holders performing any kind of work or activities in the right-of-way. The AABP may be issued to franchise holders on an annual basis to undertake blanket activities as defined by the updated Chapter 11.08.

This Bulletin summarizes Public Works application requirements for permitting activities in the right-of-way. For more information, refer to TMC Title 11.

### **Activities Covered by Right-of-Way Use Permit**

Right-of-Way Use Permits are required for work in the right-of-way, or work on private property that intersects with the right-of-way (such as connecting a driveway to a street, or side sewer to a sewer main). Other activities include but are not limited to sewer, water, surface water, street improvements, boring, culverts, curb cuts, paving, driveways, fences, landscaping, painting/stripping, sidewalks, trenching, or utility installation/repair.

### **Estimating Fees**

Right-of-Way Use Permit fees include a Base Application Fee when the application is submitted and a Permit Issuance and Inspection fee when the permit is issued. Additional fees from the fee estimate worksheet may be assessed and are based on the value of the construction work.

This form shall be used to estimate Right-of Way Use Permit fees (this is an estimate only and actual fees may vary). If you do not provide a thorough estimate based on the value of the construction work, the Permit Center will review the cost estimate for reasonableness and may adjust estimates to determine appropriate fees.

The following fee estimate sheets should help you determine what fees will apply depending on the scope of work.

*This worksheet should not be used as a substitute for codes and regulations. Your project will be reviewed for specific compliance to codes and regulations.*

10,001 – 100,000	\$49.25 for 1 <sup>ST</sup> 10,000, PLUS \$24.50 for each additional 10,000 or fraction thereof.
100,001 – 200,000	\$269.75 for 1 <sup>ST</sup> 100,000, PLUS \$13.25 for each additional 10,000 or fraction thereof.
200,001 or more	\$402.25 for 1 <sup>ST</sup> 200,000, PLUS \$7.25 for each additional 10,000 or fraction thereof.

50 or less	\$23.50
51 –100	\$37.00
101 – 1,000	\$37.00 for 1 <sup>st</sup> 100 CY plus \$17.50 for each additional 100 or fraction thereof.
1,001 – 10,000	\$194.50 for 1 <sup>st</sup> 1000 CY plus \$14.50 for each additional 1,000 or fraction thereof.
10,001 – 100,000	\$325.00 for the 1 <sup>st</sup> 10,000 CY plus \$66.00 for each additional 10,000 or fraction thereof
100,001 or more	\$919.00 for 1 <sup>st</sup> 100,000 CY plus \$36.50 for each additional 10,000 or fraction thereof.

7. PAVEMENT MITIGATION FEE \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (7)

The pavement mitigation fee compensates the city for the reduced life span due to removal of roadway surfaces. The fee is based on the total square feet of impacted pavement per lane and on the condition of the existing pavement.
