

All fire protection systems within the City of Tukwila are required by the International Fire Code to be inspected, tested, and maintained at regular intervals. These inspections ensure the system will operate properly in the event of an incident and minimize the risk of life and property loss.

Effective **February 1st, 2021**, all contractors who perform inspection, testing and maintenance services of fire protection systems within the City of Tukwila are required to electronically submit all compliant and non-compliant reports to [The Compliance Engine](#). Subsequently, property owners will receive timely proactive notifications of their testing requirements, and the Tukwila Fire Department will gain the ability to better mitigate the risk in our community by improving public safety to our citizens.

Fire Protection Systems electronically tracked by Tukwila Fire Department include:

- Smoke Control System
- Automatic Closing Fire Assemblies
- Automatic Fire Sprinkler System (Foam, Wet, Dry)
- Commercial Kitchen Hood Suppression System
- Emergency Responder Radio System/DAS
- Emergency Standby Generator
- Fire Alarm System
- Fire Pump
- Leak Detection System
- Private Hydrant System
- Spray Booth
- Standpipe

Contractors are required to submit test results to Tukwila Fire on behalf of their customers.
