

Tukwila Parks and Recreation CLOSURES and UPDATES

The Tukwila Community Center will close beginning at 6pm on March 13, 2020 through April 26, 2020. This closure is also a cancellation of all programs, activities, facility rentals, and services that occur out of the community center.

The City of Tukwila and Tukwila Parks and Recreation are committed to protecting the health of our community, facility users, and staff. This decision was in response to Governor Inslee's directives on 3/11/20 and 3/12/20 to limit social, recreational, spiritual, school, and other activities as a means of slowing the spread of COVID-19 (novel coronavirus).

Public Health recommends everyday preventative actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases including:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.

- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
