



Adopt-a-Road Safety Guidelines

These safety guidelines are provided for your benefit but are not intended to be comprehensive. The guidelines should be reviewed each time by the group before the clean-up occurs. Always use common sense, and remember "Safety First"

- Dress appropriately; loose clothing (long sleeves and long pants) are best.
- Wear closed-toe shoes.
- Wear high-visibility safety vests provided by City of Tukwila when working near traffic
- Wear rubber, latex, leather, or vinyl gloves
- Participants 15-17 years of age must be supervised by a guardian AND have a Parent/Guardian Informed Consent Form before starting work
- Litter will only be picked up from the sides of the road and sidewalk areas. Participants must stay clear of traffic at all times.
- Do not pick up trash in grass or weeds that are over 2 feet tall.
- Do not pick up hazardous/chemical materials or needles - call or email location to Tukwila Public Works at PublicWorks@TukwilaWA.gov or 206-433-0179
- Be sure to take breaks whenever needed.
- Bring your own water to stay hydrated.
- If you are uncomfortable with a location or some trash pick up, please leave and let staff know.

Trash Bag Pick Up

Place trash in trash bags and leave in a space not blocking the sidewalk or roadway. Immediately after cleanup, call or email the location of the bags to Tukwila Public Works at PublicWorks@TukwilaWA.gov or 206-433-0179 or report through the TukwilaWorks app in order to facilitate pickup.
