Why are you interested in serving as a Tukwila City Councilmember?

As a father, a business owner for over 20 years, and an immigrant, I believe I can bring a fresh perspective to the council. I envision a Tukwila that is safe for our children, welcoming to small businesses that support local families, and protective of our diverse immigrant community. After meeting with many Tukwila residents, I've heard their priorities loud and clear: public safety is the number one concern, followed closely by property taxes and the \$6 million budget deficit. We must listen to the people and take action on the issues they care about most.

If there is an area where I fall short, it is this one. I believe it's important to recognize where improvements can be made. Our city has the capacity to grow, and we must accelerate that growth, which will in turn increase property tax revenue. The 42nd Avenue Bridge and the truck re-route are also pressing issues. I do not believe these should be put on hold for two to four years. We need a viable solution now, even if it is a temporary fix. The current one-way traffic on the bridge is not working and must be rethought.

I firmly believe that together we can achieve many of our goals by working hand-in-hand with our neighbors and city staff. At the end of the day, we are here to serve the people who elected us, and we must never lose sight of that.
