PARK RULES

Welcome to your park. This is a shared public space provided for your enjoyment and recreation. We want you to have a fun and safe experience. Be courteous and respectful to others, and please keep the park clean.

Park Hours: 30 minutes before Sunrise - 30 minutes after Sunset

Motorized vehicles restricted to paved roadway and parking lot.

Pets must be on leash or under verbal/signal control.

Animal waste must be picked up and disposed properly.

Place litter and garbage in proper receptacle.

The following are prohibited in City Parks:

- Smoking within 25 feet of children's play equipment.
- Shooting firearms, fireworks, firecrackers, or explosives of any kind.
- Fires, except in designated and posted devices.
- Charcoal BBQ's, except in City-provided devices. Charcoal must be disposed of in designated charcoal receptacles.
- Bounce houses, dunk tanks, pony rides and other attractions unless authorized by City.
- Engaging in commercial activity, except by permit.
- Attaching notices to vehicles or structures.
- Causing damage to park property.
- Illegal Drugs or Alcohol.
- Hunting or harassing wildlife.
- Amplified sound that is plainly audible from 50 feet.
- Overnight Parking.

Scheduled activities through Tukwila P&R Department have priority of use. Some picnic shelters and ballfields may be reserved. For more information, please contact 206-767-2322.
